Maximum Grant: \$5,000 maximum per grant limit

* Application deadline <u>TUESDAY</u>, <u>OCTOBER 1</u>, <u>2019</u> (<u>Midnight</u>)

* Grants awarded at GSBA-RMS Annual Conference October 15,

2019 (In Athens, Ga.)

* For those selected for the grants, deadline for submitting all required documents to GSBA-RMS is FRIDAY, MARCH 20, 2020

Guidelines and Rules:

- Grant applications will be evaluated on a comparative basis. However, if grant
 proposals do not provide sufficient potential savings, GSBA-RMS reserves the right not
 to award grants.
- One (1) grant application per school district.
- Grants will be awarded on a reimbursement basis only.
- Grant funds cannot be used to reimburse equipment, training, or services purchased prior to date grant is awarded.
- Grant funds cannot be used to pay salaries for employees.
- Previous grant recipients are eligible to submit applications

Considered for Applications:

- All proposals for activities, training (including travel expenses) and/or equipment that contribute to a potential reduction in property & liability losses, employee safety, or build overall risk management awareness for members will be considered.
- Applications will be scored against others for the maximum benefit in the reduction of potential losses.

Examples:

- Training to prevent employment related claims such as wrongful termination, sexual harassment, etc.
- o Prevention of bus accidents through equipment/training, etc.

- Step ladders for classroom teachers
- Equipment/Training for food service to help prevent injuries related to strains/lifting/cuts/punctures/scrapes and burns
- To fund a slips/trips/falls program for all employees
- Train the Trainer certification in a specific program
- Purchase material handling equipment
- Ergonomically correct custodial carts/cleaning equipment
- O Construct ramps/docks to eliminate excessive material handling at dumpsters
- Slip resistant shoe wear
- Sidewalk repairs as related to student/employee/visitor falls
- Lifting equipment for special needs rooms
- Anti-slip entrance/exit mats
- Spill kits or warning signs for hallways
- Security access points of entry
- Fire safety

Not Considered for Applications:

- AED's
- Replacement and/or maintenance of current equipment

Grant Award Selection Criteria:

- Relevance to coverage the district purchases from GSBA-RMS. Example: An application for bus safety by a district that does not have auto coverage with GSBA-RMS would not be considered. An application for employee safety by a district that is not in our Workers' Compensation Fund would not be considered.
- Members can use total grant towards one of their coverage lines or divide across multiple coverages.
- If the application involves the grant money going together with <u>additional local monies</u>, we must receive full explanation of how the project will be funded. <u>All purchases must</u> <u>be completed prior to the deadline</u>. These type applications are very limited in consideration.
- Sufficient explanation of proposal and how it will help reduce losses or exposures.

EXAMPLES OF PAST GRANT RECIPIENTS

This is the 5^{th} year of the GSBA-RMS Safety Grant Program. Over \$225,000 has been distributed. Here are some examples of some of the past winners:

- To provide the necessary equipment and training for the food service department to help reduce their injuries related to strains/lifting/cuts and punctures
- To purchase 55 slip, trip and fall kits that will be placed in all schools to help control the number of incidents
- To purchase security cameras and controlled access to an OFF-CAMPUS gym that is used for athletic practices and games. Several break-ins and vandalism have caused much damage in the past
- To purchase dual band two-way radios for an elementary school that is the location of medically fragile students with multiple medical needs
- To purchase fencing to go around the playground of a specific school that is located very close to a high traffic area. There have been previous incidents.
- To purchase security cameras and access control for the bus storage/fueling area where several incidents of vandalism and theft have occurred
- For one of the poorest school districts in the state with very limited funding, to purchase and install security cameras on 3 special needs buses
- Based on number of slip, trip and fall incidents involving food service workers, purchase of comfortable, professional and slip resistant shoes for staff
- Purchase of slip-resistant mats beneath water coolers that have porcelain or vinyl composite tile
- Purchase of slip-resistant rugs, of extended length, at school entrance locations
- To purchase personal protective equipment for staff working with special needs students whose behaviors often include physical aggression
- To purchase items to correlate with their food service "Golden Hemet Award" and safety program
- To address issues of all injuries by employees, district will purchase step-ladders for classrooms, slip-resistant show wear for food service and custodians and add slipresistant rugs to entrance areas
- To purchase materials to build steps to roof-top of a school where HVAC units are located as well as fencing to prevent access to the steps for non-authorized personnel.
 Based on several injuries of maintenance workers while having to access units
- To purchase security cameras and access units for maintenance dept facility which is separate from other facilities in the district. Based on several thefts
